Please note that STG, our CFS partner, has announced that they will be eliminating both Import Wage Adjustment Fee and CFS Congestion Fee at the window, for all markets effective arrival date May 15, 2023. They will be implementing Labor and Transportation Fee that will also be effective from May 15, 2023. The ILTF will be based on CBM/800 lbs. (whichever is greater).
